All open class and Jr Class vegetables will be judged according to the Iowa State Extension Leaflet 4-H-462 that can be obtained at the Extension Office.

All products must be grown in the current year.

Entries must supply their own paper plates for exhibits.

If any entry in any class is below standard, first prize will not be awarded if only one in class.

There will be 1st and 2nd place in each class.

In the event that there is a tie for first place, (most blue ribbons), both will receive a Best Overall Ribbon.
